Warrington Dolphins Long Distance Swimming Club

In my first year of being President of Warrington Dolphins LDSC I would like to congratulate and to say thank you to everyone who has either organised, helped out or taken part in the various events that Dolphins organise throughout the year.

In February we had our 1500m Championships indoor event, this year organised by Rob Waterhouse. We had 57 entries, an excellent turnout. We had representation from a number of clubs, Warrington Tri Club, Warriors of Warrington, Trafford Metro, Barrow Long Distance Swimming Club, St Helens Tri Club, Howe Bridge LDSC, Stockport SC and Warrington Dolphins. We had a Junior 800m swim with 9 swimmers. The Junior Male 1500m was closely contested with Tommi Barnes - Warriors of Warrington taking 1st place in a superb time of 20:00s, closely followed by Adam Farini, Warrington Dolphins, in a brilliant time of 20:08s. Dominic Richard - Warrington Dolphins took 3rd place in a great time of 21:43s. Kathryn Schofield of Warrington Tri Club took first place in the Female Junior 1500m in a fantastic time of 23:14. Annie Leach of Trafford Metro had a great swim taking 2nd place in 25.21. Well done to all Junior swimmers, you all did brilliantly showing a tremendous high level of swimming at a young age. In the Senior Ladies 1500m Championships, it was 1st 2nd and 3rd for the Warrington Dolphins, with Jackie Carribine taking first place in a fantastic time of 22:18, Michaela Richard in 2nd place in 23:34 and third place to Alison Wilson in 25:18. The Senior Male 1500m Championships was also 1st, 2nd and 3rd spot for the Warrington Dolphins with Chris Rix taking 1st place in tremendous time of 18:28s. Mark Jones took 2nd place in a brilliant time of 19:05s and Richard Taylor taking 3rd in a great time of 20:38s. Irene Meikle from Barrow LDSC won the Ladies 1500m Breaststroke swim in a fantastic time of 29:51. A good time was had by all with a lovely Buffet afterwards.

In the same month our Treasurer Caroline Lewis organised the Postal Swim for the club. A huge thank you to all counters - your support is massively appreciated. It was a fun and challenging event with some interesting results. The Club had a total of 37 entries and collectively swam 4,258 lengths (106,440m). Overall totals senior men: (15 entries) 1,859 lengths, senior ladies: (9 entries) 1,058 lengths, junior boys: (8 entries) 862 lengths, junior girls: (5 entries) 478 lengths.

A number of the Club swimmers achieved noticeable success in their individual age groups, medal winners Michaela Richard and Graham Padgett took gold, Richard Taylor silver and it was a bronze for Stephne Douglas. Whilst in the team events, gold medals were won by: Anita Dodd, Michaela Richard, Julie Trevor (ladies over 45yrs) total swim 9773ms. Rob Waterhouse, Richard Taylor, Steve Elliot (gents over 35yrs) total swim 11145ms. Mark Jones, Rob Waters, Ian McCall (gents over 55yrs) total swim 9910ms. Graham Padgett, Chris Carter, Stuart Ainsworth (gents over 65yrs) total swim 9300ms. It was silver for Alan Pomfret, David Bowker, Ian McCall (gents over 55yrs) total swim 7270ms, and bronze for Tim Hughes, Adam Farini, Conor Lynch (gents open) total swim10490ms. A big, big thank you to fellow Dolphin Mandy Reid who organises the event nationally on behalf of the BLDSA and does a magnificent job in collating all the results.

Our next event was the Bob Keating/Dick Dickinson Championships organised by Caroline Lewis. Congratulations to all winners. Steph Douglas won the senior 4km 'Bob Keating' event, Luke Atkinson was first in the junior over 11yrs 2.5km 'Dick Dickinson' swim, with Joe Lewis taking the trophy for the junior under 11yrs 1.5km event. All three swimmers completed the distances closest to their estimated time to win their events. Eight senior and four junior swimmers took part in the events and put in some really good times. It was great preparation for upcoming outdoor swims and those joining in the channel relays this year and next. Again thank you to all the counters who turned up to help. We are hugely grateful for your time and support.

Once again Dolphins took to the seas with a Channel Relay. Congratulations to this year's Channel relay team Greg O'Connell, Marc Pomfret, Adam Farini, Rob Waterhouse, Richard Taylor and Chris Carter, who successfully completed another crossing by Dolphins members, in a time of 13 hrs 39 mins on 28th June. This was a first channel crossing experience for Richard, Greg and Adam, the youngest team member, at just 17. Marc and Rob had returned for a second crossing, whilst for hardened veteran Chris, this was his 9th successful crossing. Chris also completed two new swims to us which were the Scilly Isles Challenge 5 swims over 2 days approximately 7 miles of swimming and also the Falmouth Endless Summer Swim 1 mile. Many thanks to Rob, who in addition to swimming was team manager and organiser of the swim.

Marbury Handicap held at Marbury Park outdoor pool, an annual event held on Friday 1st July. The weather was fine except for some rain at the beginning of the evening. Well done to the 15 swimmers who took part in the swim, in a water temperature of 18C. Many thanks to our members who came along to timekeep. Congratulations to Alan Pomfret who won in a time of 32m 26s. Only 6 seconds faster than his predicted finishing time. Kalliopi Sinclair came a close second, just 7 seconds off her prediction. Barbara Harding finished in 3rd place, finishing 20 seconds faster than her predicted time.

Budworth Championships - Mild water temperature was the order of the day for the 62 swimmers who took part in the day's event. Twenty three Dolphins were swimming and many more involved in the running of the event. Many thanks to Margaret Smith for providing the Club with the two trophies for the new 2mls Masters events. These were won by Club members Margaret Smith and Graham Padgett. Tobias Fox also took home the trophy for the Junior male 2mls event finishing in a respectable time of 42 mins 26 secs. Well done to everyone who took part. Many thanks to Adrian Moylan who organised the event and his team of volunteers.

Albert Dock - Seventeen Dolphin's members were part of a record number of entries in this year's event. A growing amount of interest was shown by those entering the wetsuit competitions. With swimmers coming from across the breadth of the UK, they took to the water in glorious sunshine (air temp at approximately 20C and water temp 19C) and were undeterred by the number of jelly fish basking in the warm temperatures. Dolphin members were successful across the different events. First places went to Julie Trevor Ladies 4mls freestyle, Graham Padgett Gents 2mls freestyle, Ellie Jane Knight Junior 2mls breaststroke and Beth Dowding Junior 2mls wetsuit. Many thanks to the members, friends and family who assisted in making this another successful event, volunteers from Liverpool Canoe Club in providing excellent water safety cover and to Liverpool Watersports Marina for great food and facilities.

This summer we have seen several of our junior swimmers achieve considerable outdoor success. As previously reported, 17yrs old Adam Farini had a great experience of his first Channel relay swim and Tobias Fox (age 15yrs), won the male 2mls Junior event at the Budworth Championships.

It has also been a remarkable summer for two of our female juniors. In addition to their successes in the both the Budworth and Albert Dock Championships, Ellie Jane Knight and Beth Dowding, both 14 yrs old have also competed in other open water events. Well done to all our junior swimmers who have taken part in open water long distance events this summer.

Ellie made a weekend of it on at the BLDSA Lyn Tegid (Bala) championships. She won the 3kms event in a respectable time of 1 hr 11 mins. She then went on to swim 5kms on the Sunday, finishing first in the breaststroke event in 1 hr 32 mins. Ellie received the junior 2mls Breaststroke trophy at the Albert Dock Championships. Beth Dowding took part in the Great Manchester Swim, completing the mile event in 24 mins 29 secs. She was 3rd female to finish

in the 16 – 19 years age category and 10th female overall out of 770 entrants. She also completed a 5kms swim at Uswim's Open Water Festival at Salford Quays finishing 1st female. Beth competed in the 'Chill-swim' Coniston end to end event (5.25mls) and hopes to be part of a 2018/19 Dolphins Channel Relay team. Dolphins were represented at the Dee Mile swim by Michaela Richard, Karen Hodgkins and Richard Taylor, who all entered the 2km Allcomer (non- wetsuit) event.

Out of 23 starters, Michaela finished 2nd lady overall in a time of 29 mins 45 secs. Karen finished 18th, her first time in this event, in 43 mins 42 secs, out of 23 starters. Richard finished 4th in the gents, in 27 mins 28 secs out of 18 starters.
