### WARRINGTON DOLPHINS LONG DISTANCE SWIMMING CLUB

#### ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1978

I am pleased to report another successful season with 26 wins, 15 second places, 7 third places and 11 records going to our members in a total of 757½ miles.

Outstanding was Steve Dockery with a total of 62 miles, taking eight first places, three second places, four records and who in a fine individual swim captured both the Junior record and the British Men's Senior record for Windermere.

The highest individual mileage developed into a three man race between Chris Carter, Trevor Symmons and Chris Green, eventually being resolved in that order with  $89\frac{3}{4}$ ,  $85\frac{1}{2}$  and  $80\frac{1}{4}$  miles respectively. In achieving these totals Chris Carter took 2 second places and 3 third places in championships. Trevor took part in the first round the Isle of Wight relay and Chris Green claimed the "World Record" for Loch Earn on Breast Stroke.

Perhaps the greatest disappointment fell to Alan Humphries who, when with his Channel attempt imminent, sustained an injury which forced him to postpone until next year. Alan, however, totalled 57 miles with wins in the International Trial and Walton-Clacton, two second places and selection for the National team. I am sure we all wish him well in his Channel attempt next year.

Paul Tew now in training for a two-way Channel attempt next year totalled 48% miles whilst Bill Dutton, 34 miles, reclaimed "his property" when he won Morecambe Bay for the fourth time.

That well known trio Dave Palmer, Vincent Gorman and Arthur Carr had good starts in distance swimming with totals of 39,  $30\frac{3}{4}$  and  $22\frac{3}{4}$  miles respectively, each including a Windermere swim.

Claire Allman was again dominant in the junior races winning 7 championships and taking 4 records. Another stamping his mark was Ron Evans with 3 wins and 3 second places in his  $38\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

Margaret Smith was another member hampered by injury this year, but still totalled a creditable  $28\frac{3}{4}$  miles whilst Maurice Ferguson had what for him was a quiet season with  $24\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

Veterans Ken Bailey 26 miles and Lillian Brookes Bell  $25\frac{1}{2}$  miles, both had good seasons once again, Lillian taking a Breast stroke 2nd in two-way Bala, first veteran at Pickmere and 2nd place in the veterans championship.

Anthony Rea, Arthur Williams, Gina Clarke, John Heapy and Dilys Reynon all had a year of relaxation on the swimming side. Dilys, however, in her only swim this season won the Trentham Championship.

In their first full year in distance swimming, Sandra Macken and Dave Yeomans 5 miles and  $11\frac{1}{2}$  miles, both made good starts and will, I am sure, derive much from the sport in future years. Pat Dawson totalled  $12\frac{1}{2}$  miles, whilst John Peers achieved 19 miles before entering the R.A.F.

### WARRINGTON DOLPHINS LONG DISTANCE SWIMMING CLUB

# RULES /

- 1. This club shall be called "Warrington Dolphins Long Distance Swimming Club", and shall consist of an unlimited number of members.

  All competing members shall be amateurs.

  The club shall be affiliated to the British Long Distance Swimming Association and the Northern Counties Amateur Swimming Association.
- 2. Club's object: To promote, encourage and assist in the art of outdoor long distance swimming.
- 3. An elected executive committee shall consist of the following:President, Hon. Secretary, Hon. Championship Secretary, Hon. Treasurer,
  Hon. Coach, Hon. Publicity Officer, Hon. Assistant Coach.
  The remaining members of the Executive Committee shall be made up of club
  members, the number of such members being subject to review with regard
  to any increase in club membership. The Hon. Secretary shall have the
  discretion to call a meeting whenever he deems it necessary.
- 4. Annual subscription shall be due on 1st February or at the time of joining the club. Members joining after 31st August need pay only half a year's subscription.
- Applicants accepted for membership must be at least 12 years of age and be capable of swimming one mile, this to be witnessed by a member of the committee unless such applicant be seeking to join the club strictly as a none swimming member when the aforementioned condition of swimming ability may be waived.
  - 6. Anyone not renewing their membership by 31st March in current year shall be deemed to have let their membership lapse. They may re-apply for membership.
  - 7. The club shall have the power to expel a member or reject any application for membership by a two-thirds majority vote of the Executive Committee.
  - 8. Senior members, in order to qualify for the club badge, must swim a distance of three miles in "open" water or have served on the committee for a period of two consecutive years. Juniors must swim two miles in "open" water.
  - 9. The minimum age for the Junior Championships will be 12 years and under 16 years on the day of the Championships. The minimum age for the Senior Championships will be 16 years on the day of the Championships.
  - 10. All disputes that may arise concerning the foregoing rules shall be decided upon by a two-thirds majority vote of the Executive Committee.

    Such decision shall be final and binding.
