## John Heapy (sadly passed away on 30<sup>th</sup> December 2003)

John joined the Warrington Dolphins in 1967. Over the years John has swum as a Dolphin all over the country and even abroad.

Probably his biggest legacy to the Club is the Boxing Day Dip, which was his idea. He struggled to get the committee of the Dolphins interested in the swim and for two years his idea was rejected. On the third Christmas (1969) he announced that he was going to swim on Boxing Day at Pickmere and John Alexander said he would swim with him. The first Boxing Day race was in 1973. John has organised and attended all but one race, which he couldn't attend because of illness.

In his later years he has spent hours in a supporting roll to swimmers from all over the country particularly on Windermere and Loch Lomond. He crewed for Dave Feakes on his Two Way Windermere swim in 2001 and was his supporter when he swam the Channel in 2002.

The history of Warrington Dolphins is currently being compiled and this has uncovered some interesting facts about John, which to me demonstrate that he was probably one off the most experienced and knowledgeable Long Distance Swimmers in this Country. Plus he holds may records, which most current Long Distance Swimmers wouldn't believe were possible. Have a look at the list below, which is not complete, but will enlighten you to his ability.
